Our Labels:

- Impact Labels Microfinance, Environment, Climate Finance, Green Bonds
- Sustainability Transition Labels ESG, ESG Insurance Product, ESG Discretionary Mandate

Our Reach: Financial and insurance products from all different jurisdictions can obtain the labels, provided these products are in line with our eligibility criteria.

This Annual Report is an opportunity to reflect upon the significant milestones we have achieved and the positive journey we have undertaken together through 2023, including:

- The LuxFLAG ESG Discretionary Mandate (ESGDM) Label was granted to its first applicants, illustrating the continued evolution of the suite of labelling solutions to meet the industry demand for transparent and credible labelling of products in support of sustainable investments.
- We once again secured the International Standard on Assurance Engagements certification (ISAE 3000 Type II) from EY Luxembourg for the period from January 1st to December 31st, 2023. LuxFLAG has maintained this certification since January 2019.
- The LuxFLAG Sustainable Investment Week 2023 was certified with the Green Business Events Logo for the first time.

Looking ahead, we will continue to build on our partnerships, commit to innovation, and support the ongoing transition to a sustainable future.

ISAE 3000 TYPE II CERTIFICATION

In 2023 LuxFLAG had once again secured the International Standard on Assurance Engagements certification (ISAE 3000 Type II) from EY Luxembourg for the period from January 1st to December 31st, 2022.

This certification underscores LuxFLAG's commitment to transparency and excellence in its label issuance process for sustainable financial products.

EY Luxembourg performed a report on LuxFLAG's process of label issuance services to sustainable finance investment products. Its review, based on the International Standard on Assurance Engagements, confirms that LuxFLAG's description of its labelling services is accurate.

LuxFLAG has maintained this certification since January 2019, distinguishing itself as a pioneer and leader in the sustainable finance sector. LuxFLAG's consistent achievement of the ISAE 3000 Type II certification demonstrates its dedication to upholding the highest international standards, which sets LuxFLAG apart from its peers. It is a demonstration of LuxFLAG's solid business model, operating effectiveness, and credibility, which are reinforced by both internal and external verification.








ESG Strategies applied by LuxFLAG ESG labelled funds






